RMT members employed by GTR voted in favour of industrial action short of strike action and you have been advised previously of what this means in respect of rest day and overtime working.

Members also voted by a margin of over 3 to 1 for strike action but the undemocratic anti-union laws mean that the even though a majority voted for strike action it was just five votes short of the threshold required to make the ballot valid!

Now it has also been announced that GTR's owner, Go-Ahead, is to be sold in a deal which increased share values by 19%! Despite this greater wealth for the bosses and greater job insecurity for you, the employers are planning to press ahead with attacks on your job, pay and conditions.

This includes....

- Adding five hours to the working week!
- Mass compulsory redundancies.
- Huge job losses on trains and at stations and ticket offices.
- Massive cuts to fleet maintenance.
- No pay offer despite the cost-of-living crisis and GTR owners getting £1m+ pay packets.
- Instead, they want to issue GTR workers with lower pay contracts!

That's why your union is asking you to vote again and vote for strike action so we can meet the threshold required.

- So, if you voted last time – please vote again...
- And if you did not vote – please **DON'T ABSTAIN – USE YOUR VOTE!**
